We Offer an Open Visiting Policy

We understand that visits from friends and family are important to our patients — and these visits are an important part of the healing process. Our visiting policies reflect this understanding and we offer an open visiting policy.

Our team, nurses and caregivers are all committed to maintaining a patient-family centered environment here at El Camino Health, and will make every effort to accommodate visits to our patients. The hospital does not restrict, limit, or otherwise deny visitation privileges on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, or disability.

Keeping Patients and Visitors Safe

While we encourage visits from friends and family, our visitor guidelines put patients' safety and well-being above all else. That means that in particular departments or circumstances we may have different visiting guidelines in order to protect the health of our patients.

If you have a cold or respiratory infection, we ask that you postpone your visit, for the safety of your loved one and the rest of our patients. Also, in other instances, hospital staff may need to limit a patient's visiting hours for reasons such as:

- A patient's medical condition, including a risk of infection by a visitor.
- The family's health and safety, including a risk of infection by the patient.
- A patient's wish for privacy or uninterrupted rest time.
- A non-private room, in order to assure the comfort of both occupants.
- · The need for a sterile environment.

- Any court order limiting or restraining contact.
- Behavior presenting a direct risk or threat to anyone in the immediate environment or disruptive to the functioning of the patient care unit.
- Extraordinary protections due to a pandemic or infectious disease outbreak.
- Substance-use treatment guidelines that may restrict or limit visitors.

For questions or concerns regarding a patient, ask their nurse for more information and clarification.

Other Guidelines

- El Camino Health's Mountain View campus is a smoke free campus.
- Only Mylar balloons may be brought into the hospital because of the risk of latex allergies.

Contacting a Patient

Go to the Information Desk on the first floor, and ask one of our volunteers for assistance. The Information Desk will direct you to the patient unit in the hospital unless the patient has signed a non-disclosure form or has asked that no information be given.

Gift Shops

Our Mountain View campus offers two gift shops. The gift shops are solely owned and operated by El Camino Health and all net proceeds directly benefit the hospital. Gift certificates are available for the gift shops and The Maternal Connection.

The Gift Connection and The Health Connection Gift Shop

The Gift Connection and The Health Connection gift shops are both located in the lobby of the Main Hospital. The Gift Connection offers a wide range of quality merchandise including greeting cards; fresh flowers and plant arrangements, plus stuffed animals and silk plants for critical care patients; candy, snacks and drinks; fashion and accessory items; children's gifts; home gifts; accessories and seasonal items.

The Health Connection provides a soothing environment for shoppers and is dedicated to healthy lifestyles, stress reduction and spiritual well-being. Offerings include candles, teas, natural body products; soft comfortable clothing; Asian statues and inspirational banners; calming music and thoughtful books.

Maternal Connection Store

The Maternal Connection store, temporarily located in Main Hospital 1B21, carries breast pumps and accessories for rental or purchase. The store is stocked with the most common items and those hard-to-find supplies for mothers and babies. These favorites and many more products and gifts are available. Purchases can be delivered to a patient's room.

Prayer and Meditation

The hospital offers many opportunities for reflection, including the meditative labyrinth in the entrance, a meditation room, and the lovely gardens that surround the Main Hospital.

Places to Eat

Our cafeteria, located on the ground floor of the Main Hospital, features a brick pizza oven, a grill, and a variety of ethnic foods, including Asian and Indian cuisines, to reflect the communities we serve. We buy locally grown produce whenever possible. Our demonstration kitchen hosts cooking demonstrations geared toward healthy and tasty food preparation for specific medical conditions or overall good health.

Java Junction is located on the first floor, near the West Entry of the Main Hospital. It offers a wide variety of espresso and tea drinks featuring Starbucks Coffee. Pre-packaged muffins, cookies, and health bars are also available.

The Bistro is located on the ground floor of the Main Hospital and offers gourmet coffee and teas, sandwiches, soups, salads and more. Dine in the café setting or grab something to go. Open weekdays 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. and weekends 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. (Hours subject to change.)
